

**Camp Mimanagish Nurse
Job Description 2026**



Position Type: Seasonal, Nonexempt; Reports to Camp Director

Timeframe: July 26-August 1 and /or August 9-15

Work Hours: approximately 6 hours per week, variable. Room and board provided, in residence at Camp Mimanagish, 40 miles south of Big Timber, Montana. www.mimanagish.org

Compensation: Room and Board plus cash wages based on experience.

Job Description: The Camp Nurse helps to maintain the health and safety of the staff and guests at Mimanagish. The Nurse keeps careful custody of Health Forms, keeps and administers minors' medications as instructed, and provides First Aid when needed. In the rare event of a medical emergency, the Nurse responds with care and compassion, assesses the course of action, and coordinates with the Camp Manager to take further steps. The nearest Urgent Care Clinic is 40 miles away in Big Timber. The Camp Nurse is supervised by the Camp Manager.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Review Health Forms in advance of each event
- Keep Health Forms safe and confidential
- Assist in Registration Check-In; in the case of minors, clarify medication needs
- Keep unaccompanied minors' medications organized and safe until needed
- For unaccompanied minors, administer medications according to instructions
- Respond to medical emergencies; assess and coordinate with Camp Manager and take appropriate action
- Address First Aid issues as needed
- Maintain inventory in First Aid kits throughout Camp
- Keep health equipment (AED, etc.) in good working order

Requirements:

- Good communication skills
- Licensed as a Registered Nurse in Montana
- Current CPR certification
- (Current Driver's License desirable)

Background Check and Boundary Training are provided.

Physical Aspects of the Job:

Visual and auditory ability to identify and respond to environmental and other hazards of the site and facilities, and camper and staff behavior.

Ability to maintain calm, assess and assist campers and staff in an emergency.

Ability to maintain and administer medication.

Ability to make decisions and take initiative under pressure.
